	Casus	Answer the statements you get to see about how you would act. GoodHabitz gives you tips for a better approach.
Q	Quickscan	The Quickscan does a first measurement of your current knowledge you already have about the subject you chose.
A SE	To do/ Go	The 'To do' and 'Go' part of the lessons consists of a task that you have to perform.
	Toets	You take this test after completing all the lessons. At the end you will get an insight into your results and, if you passed, you will also receive a certificate.
